As happy in a pot as in the garden, however pot culture requires that you give them a good quality John Innes No 3 mixture, and plenty of water during the growing season. Feed well with the likes of Osmocote pellets.

<u>Pruning Group 1:</u> These plants flower on growth produced the previous year and, if needed, are just given a light pruning to remove spent flowers immediately after flowering. Old, woody plants can be pruned very hard – down to a couple of feet if necessary, preferably to just above some strong healthy growth – after flowering – to remove lots of the old non flowering growth. Plants make take a year or so to fully recover and start flowering properly again. Very old plants may never recover!	
<u>Pruning Group 2:</u> These cultivars can be cut back fairly hard to between 90cm to 1.2m high – to just above a fat pair of buds/single bud, the former is better. Start pruning at the top of the plant and work your way down. Pruning is carried out at the end of February/early March	
<u>Pruning Group 3:</u> these can be cut back very hard – 23-45cm high, again just above a pair of buds/single bud – removing nearly all the previous years growth. Start pruning at the bottom of the plant. Pruning is carried out at the end of February/early March.
