Deciduous Agapanthus species come from colder regions and are generally hardier.They are drought tolerant and good coastal plants, coping well with wind and salt. They need good drainage, full sun and plenty of water during the growing season. As happy in a pot as in the garden, however pot culture requires that you give them a good quality John Innes No 3 mixture, and plenty of water during the growing season. Feed well with the likes of Osmocote pellets.</p>

<p><u>Pruning Group 1:</u> These plants flower on growth produced the previous year and, if needed, are just given a light pruning to remove spent flowers immediately after flowering. Old, woody plants can be pruned very hard – down to a couple of feet if necessary, preferably to just above some strong healthy growth – after flowering – to remove lots of the old non flowering growth. Plants may take a year or so to fully recover and start flowering properly again. Very old plants may never recover!</p>	
<p><u>Pruning Group 2:</u> These cultivars can be cut back fairly hard to between 90cm to 1.2m high – to just above a fat pair of buds/single bud, the former is better. Start pruning at the top of the plant and work your way down. Pruning is carried out at the end of February/early March</p>	
<p><u>Pruning Group 3:</u> these can be cut back very hard – 23-45cm high, again just above a pair of buds or single bud however the former is better. removing nearly all the previous years growth. Start pruning at the bottom of the plant. Pruning is carried out at the end of February/early March.</p>
